

Fluency Game Board Directions:

- 1) Students can play this game in pairs or trios.
- 2) Each student will need a copy of the game board to cut apart, and each team will need a copy of the game board to play the game.
- 3) Each student will need a counter or marker to use as a game piece to move throughout the game.
- 4) Each student will need to cut apart the game board and stack the word/phrase rectangle cards into a pile. (Make sure students mix up the order of the rectangle cards.)
- 5) Students will all begin playing at the same time.
- 6) They will need to read each card one at a time until they find the first word on the game board.
- 7) At that time, they may place their marker on the game board.
- 8) Students must continue reading rectangle word/phrase cards (aloud) until they find the next word on the game board.
- 9) Once they do, they can move their game piece/marker to the next space.
- 10) When the first student gets to the last space, he or she wins the game.
