

4Sight Skill Chart for Test Item Analysis

This chart can be used with the 4Sight student answer sheet (found on the Member Center) to complete Item Analysis. Once it's completed, it can be used to assist you when forming Differentiated Instructional groups within your classroom.

Directions:

Part 1: Write student names on the lines at the top of the skill chart (see other side).

1. Access members.successforall.com
2. Log in
3. Click "Testing Center"
4. Click "Review scores"
5. Choose the correct school, test, subject, grading period, and grade
6. Click "List tests"
7. Click "Review"
8. Click "Answer Sheet" for the first student on your chart.
9. Record incorrect items on chart (see other side) by placing a "✓" under the item number that was incorrect in that student's column.
10. Click "Back" to return to student answer sheets. Select the next student and repeat the process until all information is completed for all students.
11. Total each column and record for each tested skill. Use the data to form differentiated groups for instruction and/or reteaching.

Part 2: State Scale Score

1. Click "Reports" then "School Reports"
2. Click "Predicted State Results"
3. Choose the correct school, grading period, state scored test, classroom subject, teacher, test subject, school year, and grade. ****Make sure that classroom subject says "Homeroom".**
4. Click "Run Report"

Part 3: Performance Level

1. Click "Reports" then "School Reports"
2. Click "Classrooms"
3. Choose all of the correct information, **making sure that classroom subject says "Homeroom"**
4. Click "Run Report"
