

## Syllables Lesson:

Objective: Students will say, segment, count, read, and write two-syllable words.

### Warm-Up:

Say the words.

Use duck lips to count syllables.

Use foam squares to segment and blend syllables.

Segment all sounds in each "part."

### Decoding:

Teacher writes words on white board.

Students practice spelling orally with teacher.

Teacher demonstrates how to "Touch-n-Say." Then, continue with "We Do" and "You Do" for "Touch-n-Say."

### Connected Text:

Teacher models how to read sentences.

Students and teacher read sentence together.

Students read sentences independently. Have them show you how to "Touch-n-Say."

### Dictation:

Teacher demonstrates how to segment syllables with foam squares.

Teacher shows how to segment each "part" and how to phoneme-grapheme map it.

Teacher demonstrates how to "Touch-n-Say" once again.

Continue with "We Do" and "You Do."
