

## Word Sort ch and sh

1. Read the list of words.
2. Highlight 'ch' or 'sh' in each word.
3. Discuss/teach a motion for each – For /ch/ have students point to their chin. For /sh/ have students put their finger to their lips and make the 'Shhh' sound.
4. Cut words apart.
5. Sort words by initial sound /ch/ or /sh/. (2 piles)
6. Sort words by how many sounds are in each: 3 or 4. (2 piles)
7. Sort words by action word/naming word: (2 piles) **Action** – chop, chill, shop **Naming word** – chips, chin, shin, shell, ship, chick
8. Each student should choose 2 words from their list. Use each word in a sentence. Share the sentence with a partner. This can be done orally to build oral language or be written if developmentally appropriate.
